Aren't sex & gender the same thing??

## What is SEX?

In this context, "sex" refers to the physical characteristics of a person's body, i.e. the parts that are used to assign genders at birth or genetic information.

## What is GENDER?

"Gender," on the other hand, is a set of socially constructed behaviors and/or characteristics that are expected to go with a person's sex, although they do not always align.

## Sex and gender

do interact with each other, but they are not the same thing (1).

## What is INTERSEX?

According to Hans Lindahl, intersex activist and educator, intersex can be defined as a difference in sex traits that happens on its own and is noticeable enough to cause stigma for breaking an anatomical expectation" (6)

Intersex conditions can also be referred to as DSDs, or differences/disorders in sexual development. (5) Basically, DSDs are just different ways the body forms and/or operates that falls outside of the typical binary. Sometimes these differences are obvious at birth, other times people may live their whole lives without knowing.

There are so many variables in human sexes. Intersex conditions can be chromosomal, hormonal, or they can have to do with the sry gene, which usually instructs to form testes. (5)

## Busting MYTHS about being intersex

**Myth: it's rare**

It is estimated that as many as 2% of humans may be intersex. That's the same percentage of humans who are redheads! (4)

**Myth: it needs to be corrected**

Most of the time it does not. Surgeries performed on children and infants can cause lifelong problems including infertility, pain, incontinence, and more. (4)

**Myth: intersex folk are trans**

Intersex folk can be trans, cis, or nonbinary. DSDs refer specifically to physiological traits, while being transgender refers to one's inner understanding of their own gender. (4)

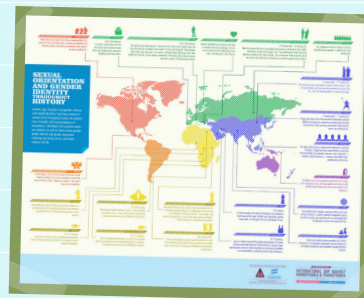
**AND**

## So what does all this mean?

- Being transgender is not new. The concept varies by culture, but there is precedent going back to ancient times that three or more genders have been recognized and respected.
- Humans come in more than two sexes, too. Our culture has pathologized different presentations, but there is nothing inherently wrong or dangerous about intersex bodies.
- Therefore, as a culture, now that we know better, we must do better. Change policies and make space for people who don't fit within binaries. Recognize the validity of human experiences that lie physically and/or internally outside the binary.
- Diversity is beautiful and. . .
- All bodies are good bodies!
